F-100D SUPER SABRE TO BE MOVED INTO HANGAR ONE

Warner Robins, GA – Museum of Aviation restoration specialists will move the F-100D Super Sabre into Hangar One tomorrow, Wednesday 11 April at approximately 10:00 AM. The time is subject to change. This airplane was flown on hundreds of combat missions during the Vietnam War by retired Major General Rick Goddard, former commander of the Warner Robins Air Logistics Center, and other pilots. Moving the F-100D into Hangar One is a major milestone for the museum, as this is the last aircraft that will go into the hangar. The move is also one of the last steps in the over six-year-long restoration of the aircraft. Members of the media are invited to observe the move and talk with museum staff. A ribbon cutting event will take place in the next few months.
