MUSEUM OF AVIATION TO HOLD WINTER WONDERFEST ON JANUARY 28 & 29

WARNER ROBINS, GA -- The Museum of Aviation Foundation will present the fourth annual Winter Wonderfest on January 28-29 at the Museum of Aviation. Doors open each day at 9 a.m. and close at 5 p.m. This year's presenting sponsor is Spherion Middle Georgia.

The Museum of Aviation Foundation had an excellent turnout for this event and has expanded the activities by double this year. Children and adults alike will enjoy the returning winter-themed activities featuring our most popular attraction from previous years, two 65 foot snow tubing slides made from real snow, along with a shorter snow tube for smaller children. Other returning activities include stunt jumpz, rock wall climbing, petting zoo, bounce houses, a hay ride around the museum, a craft show and food trucks.

This year the Foundation has added shows at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. on both days by Mike Fuller, the Magician. The biggest addition this year is a 30 foot tall zipline. A number of additional games and activities have been added, expanding the festival from the front parking lot to cover the entire museum grounds.

Winter Wonderfest will also feature real falling snow for the first time and designated snow play areas, horse rides, special exhibit vehicles, and the popular maze attraction "The Attic," will be open for an additional fee. Numerous superheroes and other well-known characters will be visiting throughout the day and will be available at certain times for photo-ops. Macon's hockey team, "The Macon Mayhem" will be available for a meet and greet on Sunday, January 29 from 2 p.m. until 4 p.m.

Armband prices are \$12 for children 6 and under and \$15 for ages 7 and up. Armband sales end at 3:30 each day. Armbands for children 7 and up include unlimited zip-lining and Stunt Jumpz, which is only available to the older children. Armbands are needed for all riders, but parents are welcome to accompany children without an armband. Parking is available across the street from the Museum at Anchor Glass.
