



# SELF-GUIDED TOURS

Thank you for your reservation for a Self-Guided Tour at the Museum of Aviation. **When you arrive, please take a moment to sign in at the volunteer desk. There should be a white binder with the sign in sheet and some maps for your group.**

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### Museum of Aviation Requirements

- The Museum of Aviation requires one chaperone for every fifteen students (K-3<sup>rd</sup>) and *at least* one adult per class (4<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup>).
- There is no charge for a Self-Guided Tour if there are less than 100 students.
- Due to the historical significance of our exhibits and artifacts, visitors are asked not to touch or climb on any exhibits and artifacts unless they have been designated as an interactive exhibit.
- No outside food or drinks are allowed inside the buildings.
- Restrooms are located on the first floor of the Century of Flight Hangar, the Eagle Building, Vietnam War-Hangar One and WWII- Scott Hangar
- The elevators are reserved for the elderly and mobility impaired visitors.
- If your group is large, please split up into smaller groups. No more than 30 students in a building at a time. Please try not to congregate inside of the doorways to allow access for all visitors.

### Teacher/Chaperone Responsibilities Include:

- Staying with their groups at all times and ensuring the safety of the students.
- Monitoring students while using the restrooms.

### Freedom Park Picnic Area

If you wish to bring your lunch, you may visit the Freedom Park picnic area located near the entrance of the Museum. Pavilions are available on a first-come first-serve basis. **Groups using the pavilions are responsible for removal of all trash.** You will be required to furnish your own garbage bags and place all trash in the adjacent dumpster before departure. \*Groups can also reserve a pavilion for \$30 charge. ### The Gift Shop

### Motion Based Virtual Reality Simulator

Experience the thrill of leaving Earth or having an adventure under the sea, without leaving the museum, thanks to an exciting new motion-based virtual reality (VR) attraction in the Museum's Eagle building. This ride seats 4 visitors per ride. Cost is \$10 per person / \$8 for field trip participants with coupon. (Ask your Museum Instructor or Tour Guide for coupons prior to your arrival.)

- **No more than 30 students in one building at one time.**
- **Students understand that other people will be visiting the Museum of Aviation. They will be polite and respectful to other visitors.**
- **Students understand that due to the historical significance of our exhibits and artifacts, visitors are asked not to touch or climb on any exhibits and artifacts unless they have been designated as an interactive exhibit.**
- **Students understand there will be no eating, drinking or chewing gum while inside the buildings.**
- **Students understand the elevators are reserved for the elderly and mobility impaired visitors.**
